## Agricultural Business Centre, Bakewell, Derbyshire DE45 1AH

### Bakewell

Bakewell is located on the A6 half way between Matlock and Buxton.



**From the M1 North**, leave at Junction 29 and take the A617 to Chesterfield, then the A619 following the signs for Buxton and Bakewell. The A619 leads you to Bakewell. Find the roundabout and follow the instructions below.

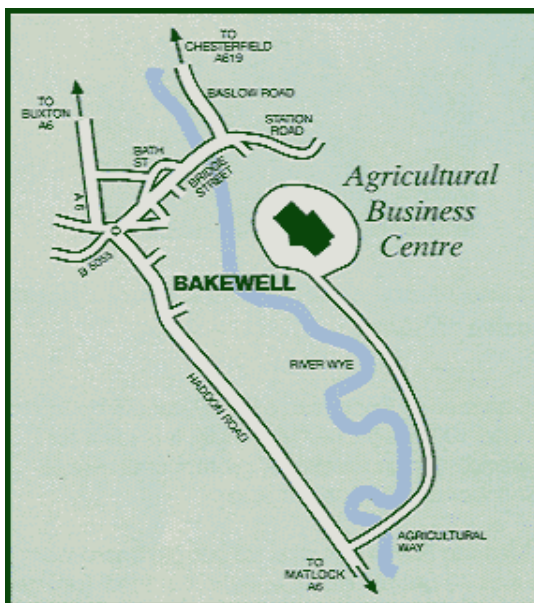
**From the M1 South**, leave at Junction 28 and take the A38 towards Derby, then the A615 to Matlock, then the A6 to Bakewell. After you pass Haddon Hall on your right, there is a long straight section of road, then you pass through the 40 MPH signs. After about 200 yards, there is a right turn, sign posted to the Agricultural Business Centre. Turn right and follow the directions below.

**By Rail**, the nearest station is Chesterfield, approximately 12 miles away. Taxis are available at the station.

### The Agricultural Business Centre – 01629 813777

***Be Careful when using Satellite Navigation, it will lead you to a closed entrance. It is best to type in the postcode of the Rutland Arms Hotel (DE45 1BT), and then follow the instructions below.***

Once in the centre of Bakewell, at the roundabout (there is only one) take the A6 South towards Matlock



After passing the recreation Ground on your left, look for the 40 MPH signs (beware, this is a 30 MPH zone and a favourite place for speed cameras).

As you approach the 40 MPH sign you will see the sign for the Agricultural Business Centre. This sign tells you to turn left.

Turn left into the approach road (Agricultural Way) and follow the road (20 MPH speed limit) until you reach the Agricultural Business Centre Building.

The Car Parking surrounds the building.
