This course is ideal for Licensing Officers, Lawyers, Councillors, Police Officers and anyone else involved in the workings of the Licensing Act.

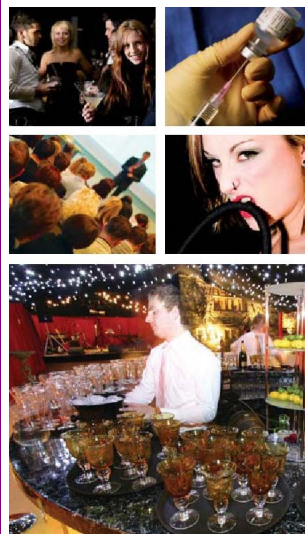
